#### CALLING ALL PLEDGE CARDS

Happy New Year! If you have not yet turned in your financial commitment card for 2008, I hope that is your New Years resolution. Cece, our office manager, has compared the records of those pledging and giving in prior years and reports that we still need to hear from many of you. In fact, the budget approved by Mission Council for the coming year requires \$460,793.40 in pledges from the congregation. To date, we have commitments totaling \$331,305.00.

The current budget is not unreasonable, as it is not much more than what was approved last year, and we have yet to receive commitments from 55 families who pledged or gave regularly in 2007. It does include some "improvements" for 2008, such as a summer intern to work with our children and youth, staff raises, and increased local outreach giving, just to name a few.

It is my hope that we will hear from those who have not returned commitment cards soon, so that your leadership can put into action our present plans for programs in 2008. As stewards of your gifts and the church's finances, we will review the pledges in relation to the currently approved budget late January or early February. If our commitments are not adequate to support what has already been approved by that time, we may have to reduce funding for some of the programs submitted by the church's missions.

Please join me in stepping forward in faith and return your commitment card for 2008. missions and programs depend on you.

#### **WEEK OF COMPASSION UPDATE**

A recently released report by the British-based ngo (non-governmental organization), Oxfam, confirms what many in the disaster response community have suspected for some time – the number of natural disasters occurring in the world is dramatically on the rise. Indeed, the Oxfam study found that the number has more than quadrupled over the past two decades. In the early 1980's the world experienced about 120 disasters per year compared to current figures of around 500 per year. The number of people affected had swelled by almost 70% - from 174 million a year between 1985 -1994 to some 254 million a year between 1995 - 2004. And as one might regrettably surmise, it is the world's poorest and most severely impacted.

Here at Week of Compassion 10 - 15 years ago, Disciples through WOC typically responded to disasters and emergencies on average of about once every 5 - 7 days. Now we are responding annually about once every 1 - 2 days.

A logical question that follows might be: what can we Disciples do? Of course, there are some simple things – give to WOC (gifts earmarked for the Compassion Response Fund are used 100% for disaster response); prepare CWS "Gift of the Heart" kits (stocks for many of the kits are essentially depleted as requests from partners throughout the world continue to grow each year); make sure your congregation has and maintains a WOC interactive map/poster (a great way to track disasters as they happen and how we Disciples respond). Stay informed – many disasters remain under-reported, even unreported, by so much of the popular media.
