# NEW CHURCH WEBSITE www.fcc-bhm.org

New Church Website went live **Saturday December 12.** The new site is loaded with new features, and we think you'll find it a tremendous improvement over the old site. Not only is it very user friendly and aesthetically pleasing, but it is also very functional. The intent of the new design was not only to modernize it, but also to make it as informative and functional as possible - not only for current church members and friends of the church, but also for people that happen upon our site through search engines by people potentially searching for a new church home.

Here are just a few features of the new website:

- A 'First Visit' tab which is prominently displayed at the top of the website, giving a potential first time visitor details on 'what to expect' when they visit our church – everything on what to wear and where to park, to details of communion.
- Videos and slideshows.
- The ability to not only view upcoming events, but also to register for upcoming events if they require registration, and for upcoming events that require a fee, you can even pay it online with your debit or credit card.
- Also, through Pay Pal we now have the ability to make our pledges and tithes which will be recorded in your giving statement.
- An online (confidential) prayer request that goes directly to our co-pastors.
- A wonderful new section called 'What Members and Friends Think of FCC', which are heartfelt testimonials of some of our

church members, sharing their thoughts about our church family.

- Many great new features kind of on the technical end, here are just a few:
- Hidden keywords enabling search engines such as Google to find our website when someone is searching for churches in our area.
- Google Analytics, which enables us to monitor and track visits to the site, how long the user stayed on each tab, etc.
- A new content management system, that allows us to much more fluidly update content, including photographs, videos, and slideshows. We can easily change the notification email for different ministries for example, if we create an event for the monthly Men's Meeting, we could place the men's ministry chair's email address in the system, so he gets notification when someone registers for the monthly men's meeting so no worries if you forgot to 'sign the sheet in the narthex', just go to the web at your own convenience to register.

It is our prayer and hope that the new website will be optimally used to the Glory of God, and that it will become a ministry and central point of communication and information. We believe that it can be a wonderful tool and a central point for bringing together all ministries from the youth groups to the elders, from the music ministry to the school (TAN), and everyone in between. We who administer the site welcome participation from all ministries, whether it is information for upcoming events you'd like to see posted on the site, or videos or photos made at events you'd like to see posted, or even a suggestion of something you think would be useful.

We want to make the new website a 'first thought' and not an 'after thought' when it comes to communications regarding any ministry.
