## **MIRACLES FROM GOD-PART II**

In last week's article, I referred to the miracle of a changed heart. I wrote of my father's and my brother's conversion to Christianity late in their lives. This week, I want to tell you about the miracle of how I came back home to Birmingham.

This story will not make any sense if I do not tell about the most wonderful man I met earlier in my adult life. It was the first day of orientation in college. My best friend, Kristie Franklin, and I were in a big auditorium listening to a very boring speaker when I noticed this tall, good-looking young man several rows in front of us whose name I would learn later was Jim Davis. Being the shy person that I am, I managed to introduce myself to him after the meeting. That was the beginning of our long-term courtship, and after graduating from Auburn in 1971, we got married. I was the high school teacher, and he was the engineer. Jim's career took us to Savannah, Georgia, where our two daughters, Natalie & Nicole, were born. Then nine years later we moved to Jacksonville, Alabama. In 1989, we moved again to Logansport, Indiana, and finally, in 1994 we moved to Brighton, Michigan. So all of my adult life, I lived away from Birmingham. Some would say that we were living the American dream. Jim was doing very well in his career, I was teaching and our two daughters were attending Western Michigan University and Michigan State University.

This happy life came crashing down on June 22, 1999. Jim had gone to Portland, Oregon on a business trip. One day after arriving in Portland, Jim died of a massive heart attack. He was only 50 years old. Had it not been for the Lord and our wonderful church family, Cornerstone Evangelical Presbyterian Church, I don't know what I would have done. But God was faithful and taught me so many things that first year. Little things that I would have gone to Jim about, I learned to ask God and to wait for His answers and His timing.

A little over a year later, my sisters and brother were trying to get me to move back to Birmingham. Everyone said to wait at least a year after Jim's death before making any major decisions. So in October, 2000, I was able to get a courtesy interview with the Assistant Superintendent of Hoover City Schools, Dr. Connie Williams. I knew that Spain Park High School was going to open the following year and maybe I could get a position there.

I remember so vividly the morning of my meeting with Dr. Williams. My appointment with her was at 1:30 pm. I woke up early that morning and I was a bundle of nerves. This was the first major decision I had made since Jim's death.

I was emotionally torn between wanting to move back home and be with my family and leaving my church family and friends in Michigan. I remember getting on my knees and crying out to God....."What do I do Lord? What do you want me to do? They are not going to hire me...I'm too old." I must have cried and had my "pity party" for twenty minutes or more.

Then I felt the Lord was telling me to get my Bible and read the daily devotional. I wiped my eyes and this was the bible verse: Matthew 6:25-34 (The parable on worrying)....."Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will take care of itself..."

Isn't God amazing? After reading those verses, I got up, wiped my eyes and got ready for my interview. I was so relaxed in the meeting that I had to keep telling myself to sit up straight. My interview was only supposed to last ten minutes because it was the end of October and school had started in August, so naturally there were no openings. After about an hour, Dr. Williams said: "Ms. Davis, when I agreed to see you this was just going to be a courtesy interview. However, the strangest thing happened this morning." I thought, how did she know that I was crying like a baby this morning? Dr. Williams continued: "We had a teacher in your field (Social Studies) who turned in her resignation this morning at 8:30. She teaches International Baccalaureate History and you walk in with a Masters' Degree in U. S. History".

I believe that miracles come in many different ways to us. Remember, I was afraid that my age would keep me from getting the job. God actually used my age and experience in teaching to get the job. God is truly wonderful!!

Start looking for those miracles in your life.
